

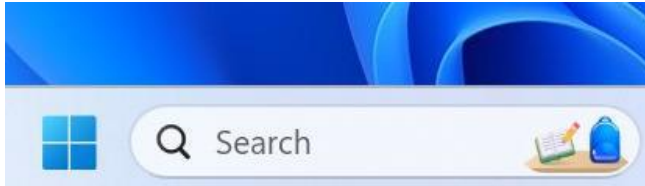


NAPLAN LOCKED DOWN BROWSER – WINDOWS GUIDE

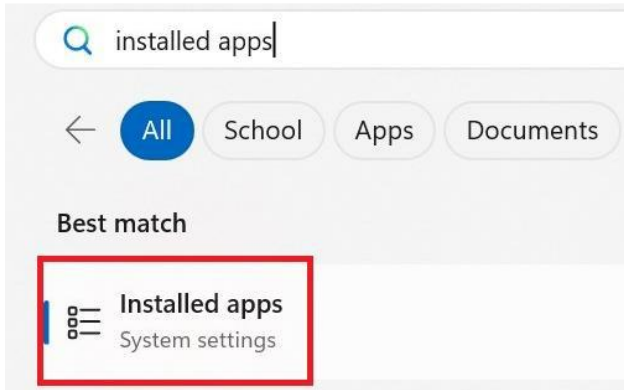
STEP 1: UNINSTALL THE OLD VERSION (IF YOU ALREADY HAVE IT)

If you installed the NAPLAN browser in a previous year, you'll need to remove it before installing the new version. This only takes a minute.

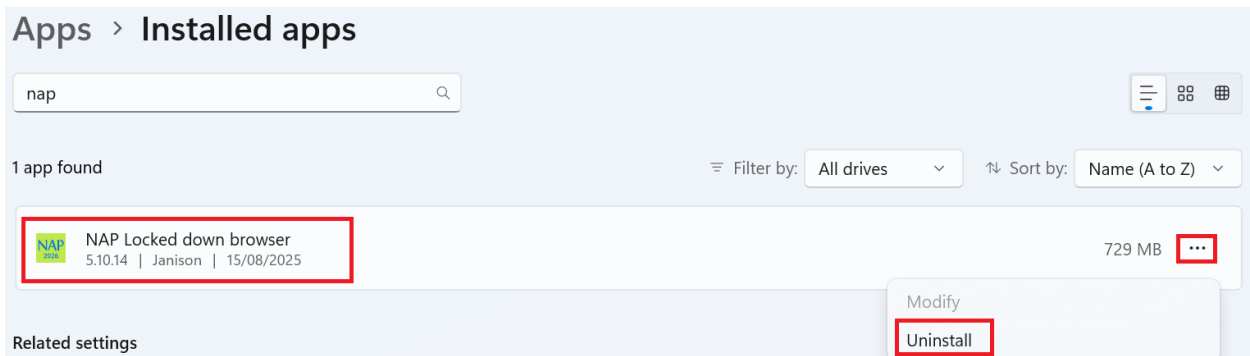
1. Click the **Windows Start** button (bottom left of your screen).



2. Type **Installed apps** and click on it.



3. In the search box, type **NAP**.



4. Click on **NAP Locked down browser**.
5. Click the **three dots** next to it.
6. Select **Uninstall**.
7. If a confirmation box appears, click **Yes**.

It may take a short moment to finish. Once it disappears from the list, you're ready to install the new version.

If you don't see it listed, that just means it isn't installed - you can move straight to Step 2.

STEP 2: DOWNLOAD THE NEW BROWSER

1. Go to the Online National Assessment Platform website.
<https://www.assessform.edu.au/naplan-online/locked-down-browser#downloads>

2. Select the **Windows** download button.

3. The file will be downloaded automatically to your **Downloads** folder.

If nothing seems to happen, check the bottom of your browser window or your Downloads folder - it's likely already there.

STEP 3: INSTALL THE BROWSER

1. Open your **Downloads** folder.
2. Double-click the file called **NAP Locked down browser**.

3. If Windows asks if you want to allow changes, click **Yes** - this is normal.
4. Click **Next**.

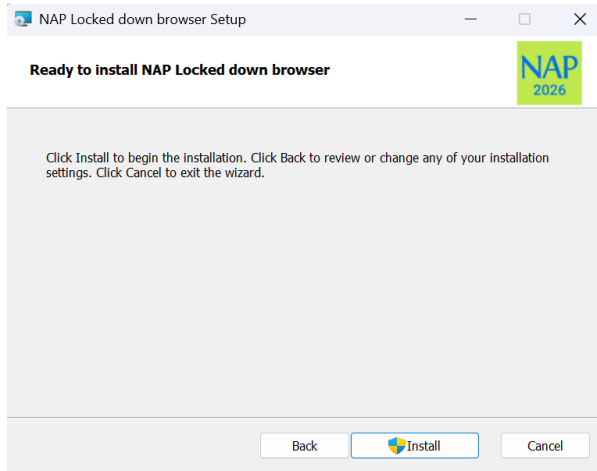

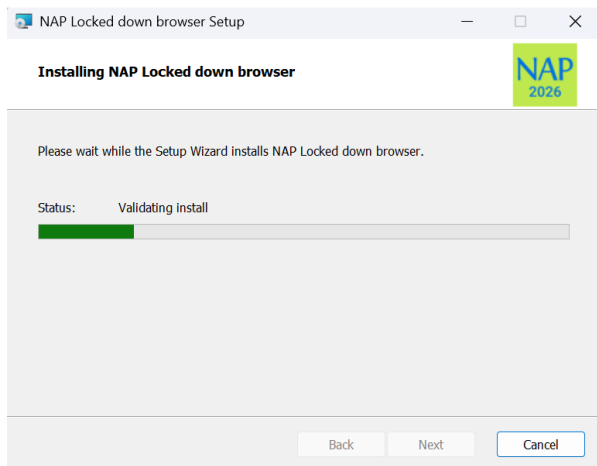

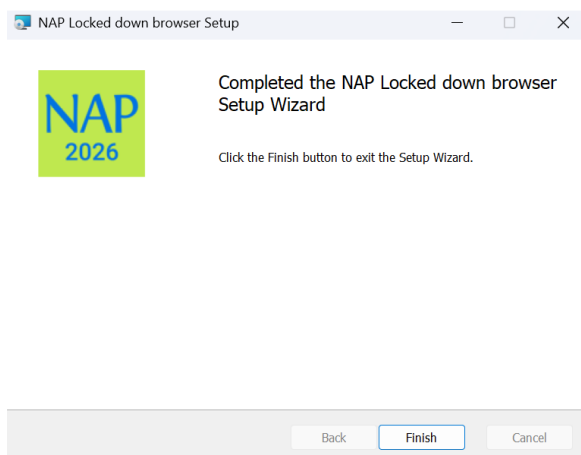
5. Click **Install**.



6. Wait while it installs.



7. Click **Finish** when it's done.



The installation may take a minute. Just let it finish - you don't need to do anything while it's installing. When it's complete, you should see a **NAP Locked down browser** shortcut on your Desktop.



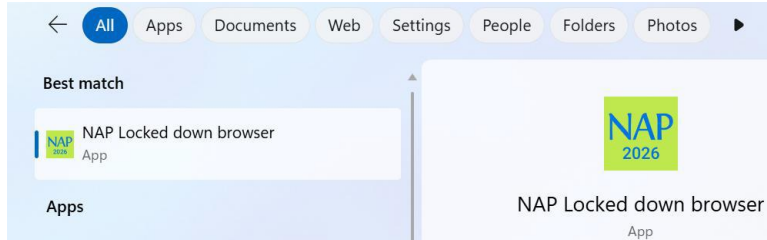

STEP 4: OPEN THE BROWSER TO CHECK IT INSTALLED OK

1. Click the **Windows Start** button.
2. Type **NAP Locked down browser**.



3. Click it to open.

Note: The first time it runs, Windows may do a quick check. This is normal and doesn't mean anything is wrong. Depending on your network settings, you may encounter some system checks on first launch of the application. For example;

Windows Security
